The magnitude of the effect of the type of feedback on the opportunity difference is a function of the type of response and the magnitude of the incentive. When the incentive was low, the opportunity difference was small, and the type of response had little effect. When the incentive was high, the opportunity difference was large, and the type of response had a significant effect. The effect was very significant for the results with a high incentive when the opportunity difference in the amount of ^{222}Rn extracted was high. The subjects who had the high incentive extracted significantly more ^{222}Rn than the subjects who had the low incentive when the opportunity difference
