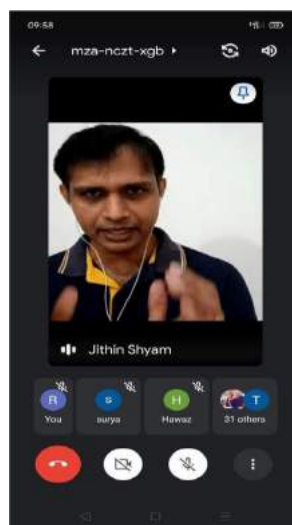
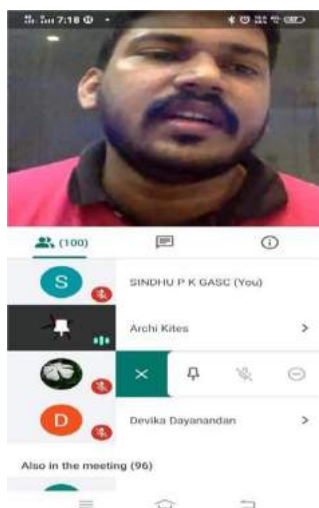
“Effective Communication Skill” was completed in two sessions by Rajesh K. V. (Life skill and ORC trainer)
