






DEPARTMENT OF MICROBIOLOGY SOAP MAKING WORKSHOP



1. FLOOD RELIEF ACTIVITIES



2. COVID 19 PANDEMIC ACTIVITIES


Sanitizer, mask distribution and awareness programme






World Environment Day








International forest day celebration


5. BLOOD DONATION PROGRAMME






6. HAIR DONATION




12.LIVELINE
