UNION ACTIVITIES

The college day celebration, Onam and Christmas celebrations, fresher's day, farewell programme are the main events that have been organized by the Students Union of the institution. In 2018 College union renounced the Onam festival due to the unprecedented heavy flood in Kerala. The entire amount collected for the fest was contributed to the Chief Minister's flood relief fund. They also collected other necessary goods from the students, teachers and other well-wishers and handed over to the flood afflicted people. The college union conducted a cultural fest instead of the Onam fest for students when situations and weather became favourable. Nanma Niracha Ruchi, was an event initiated by the Union to provide food to orphans. Representation of the college union is also clearly visible in academic activities like seminars, conferences, workshops etc. In addition, the College union publishes College magazine every year. The college published its' first online magazine in the year 2019-20 due to the Covid 19 pandemic. The members of the college union give enough opportunities to all the students to come up with their creative ideas on any single topic which is relevant to the scenario. The editorial board selects the works which are to be published. The active participation in all social activities is one of the remarkable qualities of Gurudev's college union. As a part of the above, the union organized a hair donation campaign. 80 students from our institution have donated their hair and actively participated in the campaign. Gurudev college union provided transport facilities, to students considering the difficulties they faced to appear for the university examination. After the examination, the union members and the SFI unit were very vigilant to disinfect the exam hall and college premises. The SFI unit of Gurudev College also donated mobile phones to students who experienced financial difficulties to buy phones for online classes.
