




1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class? 544 responses




2. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes? 544 responses




3. How well were the teachers able to communicate? 544 responses




4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as 544 responses



5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers $^{544\,\mathrm{responses}}$




6. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you? 544 responses










11. Your mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you.




12. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications. 544 responses




13. The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges.










