

SCHOLARSHIP POLICY

The prime concern of Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe Scholarship is the progress in education. Educational programs are being carried out on the basis that the everlasting growth of any society is possible only with its educational developments.

OBJECTIVE

The main objective of the scheme is to appreciably increase the Gross Enrolment Ratio of Scheduled Caste (SC) and Scheduled Tribe (ST) students in higher education with a focus on those from the poorest households, by providing financial assistance at post-matriculation or post-secondary stage to enable them to complete their education. It helps the students by Modernizing their lifestyle by conserving the culture, Preservation of traditional knowledge and total literacy in our state.

Scholarships will be awarded to the students considered under the below criteria. The renewal applications would be fully exhausted before the new applications are considered:

- 1. Students belonging to SC/ST community irrespective of caste are eligible for this scholarship.
- 2. Students have to apply online to the institution heads with caste, income copy of bank a/c passbook, concerned educational qualification certificates.

- 3. The annual income of his/her parents/guardians from all sources not exceeding Rs.2 Lakhs.
- 4. Both Day scholar and hostellers are eligible to apply.
- 5. If a student violates any other term and condition of the scholarship, the scholarship may be suspended or cancelled immediately without further notice.
